

**Elizabeth Township Park Board
Meeting Minutes for July 2nd, 2015**

In Attendance: Tom Moyer, Lisa Rothermel, Steve Garman, Rodney May, Maria Tivoli, and Ken Fillo, and others.

The meeting was called to order outside on the basketball court at 7:00 p.m.

Pete Parsil and Brooke Minnich had set up the basketball court for a demonstration of "PickleBall." They showed how the game is played and members of Board participated in a few games.

The demonstration ran until 7:25.

Rodney May updated the group regarding the recent inspection of the play ground at the Township building. The equipment currently in use does not meet the new standards in that the existing distance between the bars is greater than 4 inches. The supervisors and Glenn Martin are looking at workarounds to meet the new standards so that we won't be required to replace all of the existing equipment.

Maria updated the group regarding the status of the Lititz Springs Pool. The pool is in need of repair and remodeling due to its age. She is in the process of putting together a survey to get data regarding the usage by the residents of the WRRRC area, in order determine how cost sharing should be distributed.

Rodney stated that the Township plans to repave the roadways and parking areas at the park with a 1.5 inch overlay.

Glenn Martin is in the process of soliciting bids for sealcoating of the basketball court at the Township building. Pete and Brooke are hoping that the Supervisors will also restripe the court to allow for pickle ball to be played on the court. They also donated a portable net for use by pickleball players. The net will be stored at the Municipal building and available to registered users.

The new drainage pipe, that was installed adjacent to Baseball field #1, seems to be working with the current wet weather.

Tom Moyer will not be available for the next meeting which will be held on Thursday, September 3rd.

The meeting adjourned at 8:15 p.m.
