

**Elizabeth Township Park Board**  
**Meeting Minutes for March 12<sup>th</sup>, 2015**

The meeting was called to order at 7:03 p.m.  
The minutes of the previous meeting were approved as written.

The Lititz Youth Soccer Club's proposal to utilize the Fields before 1 p.m on Sunday, July 26<sup>th</sup> still has to be presented to the Supervisors for approval.

The Community yard sale to be held on March 28<sup>th</sup> in conjunction with the Keener Rd. yard sale was approved by the Supervisors.

The Supervisors approved the request to hold the "Chase Your Tail 5k Benefit Run" on April 18<sup>th</sup>. The Group has provided a certificate of insurance for the event. They will be sending out letters to the residents of Keener Road with details of the road closure for the approximately 45 minute-1 hour time frame that the race will entail. The route will consist of 2 laps around the park's walking path down Keener Road to the turnaround point and return.

Community Yard sale: As of this date Tom had not received any calls requesting a space at the Yard sale. Steve Garman made a sign for use at the Park entrance at Rt. 322. Since this is the first time for this event, we didn't contact any food trucks for the event, since we cannot predict what kind of attendance numbers we might have. Also, the Fire Company's Chicken Barbecue will be held on that same date. Rodney May stated that the Township will provide crossbucks and traffic cones for the day. He will turn on the systems at the rest rooms for the day. Lisa stated that she has sidewalk chalk for marking spaces.

Maria reported that she had been in contact with Agricultural Veterinarians Association who would like to move their annual Carnival from the Fire Company's property to the Township Park. The event would be held on Thursday, August 6<sup>th</sup> from 4-10 p.m. They would like to use the pavilion. They have held small fireworks displays in the past. Would the Supervisors waive the rental fee in lieu of a donation?

Volleyball Smash Tournament: the Organization has previously requested to use the Township park on August 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> to conduct their annual fund raiser for Cancer. They have outgrown the site that they traditionally use at the Warwick Township Linear park. The event entails the use of 40 volleyball courts and runs into the evening on Saturday with temporary lighting, and continues on Sunday to about 6 p.m. The group usually provides porta potties for the event. Warwick Township usually charges a fee for the use of their facilities. Maria stated that it appears that the organization has made tentative arrangements for the event at another Warwick Township Facility.

The next meeting will be held on Thursday, May 7<sup>th</sup> at 7p.m. at the Elizabeth Township Municipal building.

The meeting adjourned at 7:49 p.m.
