Meeting Minutes for November 5th 2015

The meeting was called to order at 7:01 p.m.
The minutes of the September meeting were approved as written.

The basketball court at the township building was resealed and restriped.
The speed bump in the park will be re-installed.

Pete Parsil picked up the pickle ball equipment since it is the end of the season.
The Supervisors will discuss the cost involved to stripe the basketball court at the Township building for use as a pickleball court.

Brian Wiker had talked at the previous Supervisors' meeting about trying to organize a community clean-up day. It could be held on earth day in the spring (Friday, April 22) or perhaps in the fall. Items to consider would be mulching, garden planting, leaf cleanup, etc. The Township would provide rakes, gloves, drinks etc.

April 16th is booked for the 2nd Annual "Chase Your Tail" 5k race.

Speedwell Heights Brethren in Christ Church did a clean-up around Speedwell Rorge Road, Pumping Station Road and Seglock Road. Pastor Forrey is the contact person. Perhaps they will be willing to participate. So we will tentatively aim for a clean-up on Saturday, April 23rd, with a rain date the following week.

Warwick Little League will extend the base path at field #2 to 90 feet to accommodate their 14-16 age bracket.

There was a discussion about adding other amenities to the park such as perhaps Frisbee golf (around the perimeter of the park) quoits/horseshoes(add a lock box at the pavilion for use by renters) or a sand volley ball court adjacent to the pavilion.

Maria is trying to contact Lori Yeich at DCNR about the timing of this year's grant cycle in regard to replacing the playground equipment at the Township building.

The meeting adjourned at 8:04 p.m. The next meeting will be held on Thursday, January 7th at 7 p.m.
