

**Elizabeth Township Park Board**  
**Meeting Minutes for March 6<sup>th</sup>,2014**

**In Attendance:** Tom Moyer, Lisa Rothermel, Steve Garman, Rita Snavely, Rodney May, Carol Weaver, and Ken Fillo.

The meeting was called to order at 7:05 p.m.

Ken Fillo made a motion to retain the existing slate of officers. Steve Garman seconded the motion and all the members approved the motion.

The minutes of the November 2013 meeting were approved as written. (The January 2014 meeting was canceled due to inclement weather).

Since we have received an above average amount of snowfall this season, the park has seen some sledding activity on the hill in the northwest corner of the park. Glenn does not plow the roadway thru the park or parking areas but the park is being utilized for some winter activities.

The second baseball field was completed in the fall.  
Little League and traveling baseball will use both fields in the springtime.

Curt Strasheim (former WRRC director) moved to South Carolina.  
The Board and the Supervisors appreciated the work that he did as the director and found his input during the process of creating the park was very helpful.  
The Supervisors will have a meeting on March 10<sup>th</sup>, with the other members of WRRC, to discuss what roles and the degree of participation Elizabeth Township will have as the WRRC moves forward.

The screening project for the rest rooms is on hold at least until the springtime of 2014.

The Supervisors are still considering a springtime volunteer clean-up for the park, which would most likely entail spreading fresh mulch, weeding and trash removal.

Lititz Run Watershed Association will conduct its annual stream clean up in April.

Elizabeth Township is looking for volunteers for Waterway clean up ideas.  
One item that was mentioned was to stencil stormwater inlets as part of the Chesapeake Bay Watershed.

The Township's newly revamped website ([www.elizabethtownship.net](http://www.elizabethtownship.net)) is up and running.

There was a discussion regarding a large manure spill that occurred on Newport road in Halfville.  
Glenn was called to the site and DEP was there also.

The next meeting will be held on Thursday, May 1<sup>st</sup>, 2014 at 7:00 p.m.

The meeting adjourned at 7:30 p.m.
