## **Manure Management Plan Manual**

In November, 2011 PA Department of Environmental Protection (DEP) released the manual/workbook for farmers to use for their Manure Management Plans.

**All farms in PA that produce or use manure, regardless of size, are required to have and implement a written Manure Management Plan.** The new manual-workbook is the format to be used and once the workbook is completed it becomes the farm's Manure Management Plan. It can be prepared by you, the farmer, without any type of certification and the plan does not have to be reviewed by any authority, but the plan needs to be available at the farm for PA DEP or conservation district staff to see when they visit your farm.



Lancaster County Conservation District ag staff will conduct Manure Management Plan workshops, **9 AM — 2 PM (includes lunch) at no cost to you.** If you bring the information listed below you can go home with a completed plan.

1. Soil test & manure test reports
2. Animal types & number
3. Manure storage size
4. Crops grown & rotation
5. Manure application rates
6. Farm map (optional, maps can be printed on location)
