

Elizabeth Township Park Board

Meeting Minutes for 07/07/2022

In attendance:

Tom Moyer. Mike Landis, Rodney May, and Ken Fillo. Lisa Rothermel, Steve Garman and Ron Stief were excused.

The meeting was called to order at 7:02 p.m.

The minutes of the March 2022 meeting were approved as written.

5 boards of the “GAGA” pit were replaced.

The floors of the rest room will be resurfaced on 7/11 and 7/12th. Due to the contractor’s short notice, a porta- potty will not be brought to the site.

The automatic locks on the rest room have been repaired and now function properly. They open at 6 a.m. and lock at 9 p.m. The outside lights have been replaced. The water fountain has been removed from service due to maintenance costs.

Ken Fillo sprayed the underside of the roof of the Pavillion with “Wet and Forget”. Since the product relies on the effect of rain and wind to work, Ken followed up by using a pressure washer to simulate the effects of rain. He plans to continue make weekly visits to continue this action.

The board recommends to the Supervisors, that the current basketball court at the Township building be expanded to 60ft. x 70ft. to accommodate 2 pickleball courts.

Chuck and Lorrie George plan to replace the existing “little library box” with a new one rather than repairing and repainting the one currently on site.

Mike Landis raised a concern regarding a scheduling conflict about use of the baseball fields and the Amish Ascension Day activities. He suggested that we be more aware of the events and resolve the scheduling conflict in the future.

At the March meeting, Mike suggested that we look into possibly adding some more playground equipment geared towards ages 12-16. He did some research and found that the equipment was very expensive. It was suggested that we contact Kevin Zook at the rec-center, (Kevin performs the playground inspections for WRRRC.) for some suggestions.

Free Trees: Loren Miller had sent the group an e-mail regarding free bare root trees that are available from TreePennsylvania.org. The group discussed potential locations for some more trees at the park. The areas were, along the north side of the fairway of disc-golf hole #9, near the tee-pad of hole #1, between the walking path and the North

parking lot, southwest of the backstop for baseball field #2, south of the tee pad for hole #8 (adjacent to the property line.). The group felt that we should apply for 15 trees.

The Baron Stiegel Lions club will hold a community concert at the park, on Saturday, 7/16 from 5- 9 p.m. Their food truck will be on site.

The next meeting will be held on Thursday September 1st, 2022

The meeting adjourned at 7:45 p.m.
